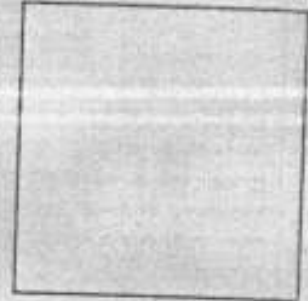

Scouting/Guiding, also known as Scouting (Guide) Movement, is a worldwide youth movement with the stated aim of supporting young people in their physical, mental and spiritual development, so that they may play constructive roles in society.

Scouting began in 1907 when Robert Baden Powell, Lieutenant General in the British Army, held the first Scouting encampment at Brownsea Island in England.

As a military officer, Baden Powell was stationed in British India and Africa in the 1880s and 1890s. Since his youth, he had been fond of woodcraft and military scouting and as part of their training showed his men how to survive in the wilderness. He noticed that it helped

the soldiers to develop independence rather than just blindly follow officers orders.



The Boy Scout movement swiftly established itself throughout the British empire soon after the publication of 'Scouting for Boys'. The first Scout rally, held in 1909 at The Crystal Palace in London, attracted 10,000 boys and a number of girls. By 1910, Argentina, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, India, Malaya, Mexico, the Netherlands, Norway, Russia, Sweden and the United States had boy Scouts.

The program was initially focused on boys aged 11 to 18, but as the movement grew, the need became apparent for leader training and programs for younger boys, older boys and girls. The first Cub Scout and Rover Scout programs were in place by the late 1910s.

Girls wanted to become part of the movement almost as soon as it began. Baden-Powell and his sister Agnes Baden-Powell introduced the Girl Guides in 1910, a parallel movement for girls. Sometimes named Girl Scouts.

2. SCOUT PROMISE AND LAW

"On my honour, I promise that I will do my best" to do my duty to God and my country to help other people" And to obey the Scout/ Guide Law.

Law/ನಿಯಮ

Note:- There is only one law. The law has 9 points

- 1) A Scout/ Guide is trustworthy.
- 2) A Scout/ Guide is loyal.
- 3) A Scout/ Guide is a friend to all and a brother/ sister to every other scout/ Guide.
- 4) A Scout/ Guide is courteous
- 5) A Scout/ Guide is a friend to animals and loves nature
- 6) A Scout/ Guide is disciplined and helps protect public property
- 7) A Scout/ Guide is Courageous.
- 8) A Scout/ Guide is thrifty
- 9) A Scout/ Guide is pure in thought, word and deed.



Agnes Baden-Powell became the first president of the Girl Guides when it was formed in 1910, at the request of the girls who attended the Crystal Palace Rally. In 1914 she started Rosetreds later renamed Brownies - for younger girls. She stepped down as president of the Girl Guides in 1920 in favor of Robert's wife Olave Baden-Powell who was named Chief Guide [for England] in 1918 and world Chief Guide in 1930.

Baden-Powell could not single-handedly advise all groups who requested his assistance. Early Scoutmaster training camps were held in London in 1910 and in Yorkshire in 1911. Baden-Powell wanted the training to be as practical as possible to encourage other adults to take leadership training. A wide range of leader training exists since 2007, from basic to program-specific including the Wood Badge training.

Parts of Uniform / ಸಮವಸ್ತ್ರದ ಭಾಗಗಳು

The Scout Uniform - Compulsory Components.

* Shirt: A gray color shirt with half sleeves two patch pockets and shoulders strips

* Shorts: A navy blue shorts or trousers.

* Head dress: A navy blue beret cap with the official badge. a Sikh may wear a turban.

* Belt: - Brown leather or khakhi web belt with the official buckle of Bharath Scout and Guide

* Scarf: - A triangular scarf of the group color other than yellow, green, and purple. [70 cms and not more than 30 cms in length]

* Membership badge: - Stich the badge in middle of the left pocket or at the same place on coat

* Shoulder badge: - 8 cms in length and 1.5 cms in width.

* Shoulder strips: - Two shoulder strips indicating the name of the patrol each 5 cms x 1.5 cms

* Stockings or socks: Black of khaki with green garter tabs 1.5 cms visible

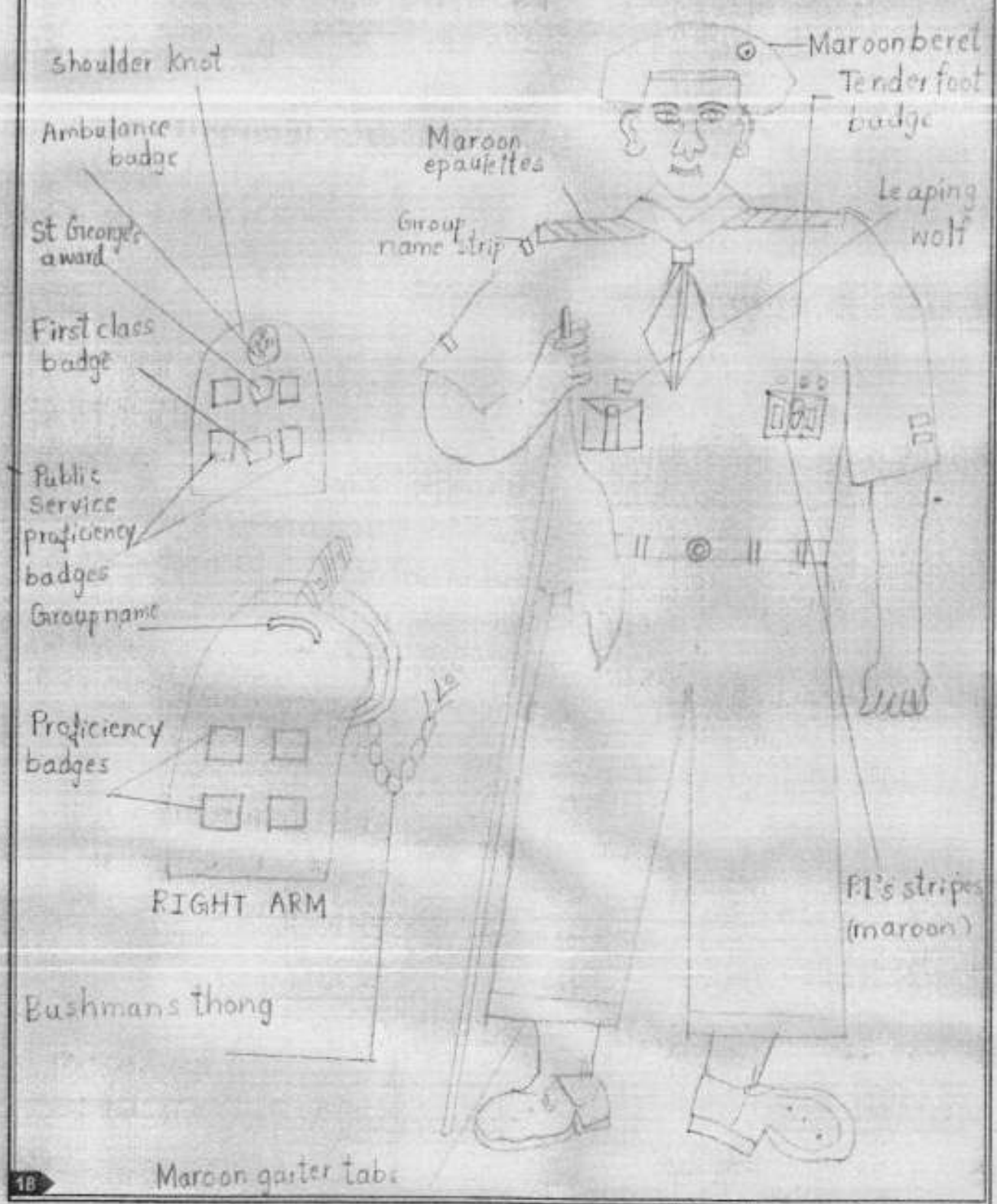
* Foot wear: Brown or black shoes.

* World scout badge: Made of cloth may be worn in the middle of the right pocket when in uniform

Be prepared in Mind by having disciplined yourself to be obedient to every order and also by having thought out beforehand any accident or situation that might occur. So that you know the right thing to do at the right moment and are willing to do it.

In Hindi, the translation is "Taiyyar" or "तैयार"
